USER NOTE: The function floodplain (Flood Zone 3b) is defined in larger towns (Abingdon only) by the in-channel extent. This was agreed so that the urban area is no longer defined as functional floodplain. In towns and larger villages it is defined by the extent of the 5% AEP extent. In smaller villages and other areas the functional floodplain is defined as equivalent to Flood Zone 3. The legend below allows users to identify how the functional floodplain is defined for each settlement.
