ADOPTION STATEMENT

Notice is hereby given by Vale of White Horse District Council in accordance with Regulations 17, 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), that the Vale of White Horse Local Plan Part 2 ("LPP2") was adopted by Council on 9 October 2019.

The Plan was the subject of an independent examination conducted by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. In his report, published in June 2019, the Inspector concluded that subject to the incorporation of the Main Modifications, LPP2 satisfies the requirement of Section 20(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and meets the criteria for soundness in the National Planning Policy Framework.

All the main modifications have been incorporated into the adopted LPP2 and Policies Map.

LPP2 and the Policies Map, now forms part of the statutory development plan for the Vale of White Horse District.

LPP2 and other associated documents will be made available to view online on the council's website.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of LPP2 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) on the ground that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; or
- b) a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any application must be made before the end of the period of six weeks beginning with the day after the date of adoption by the Council (9 October 2019).
