Cumnor Neighbourhood Development Plan – Vale of White Horse District Council response to Examiner’s Clarification Note of 7 January 2021

In your clarification note dated 7 January 2021 you asked the District Council the following:

I saw that there were footpaths to the west and to the south of the Cumnor Cricket ground.

I also saw several people walking through the Cricket Ground. Is there a separate public footpath which runs to the north (rear) of the Cricket Ground pavilion and then along the vehicular access to the pavilion from Appleton Road?

We contacted Oxfordshire County Council and they have confirmed that no public right of way is recorded along the north of the Cricket Ground pavilion and then along the vehicle access to the pavilion from Appleton Road as you have described, but that is without prejudice to any unrecorded rights.

Information regarding public rights of way can be accessed from the Oxfordshire County Council website, legal changes made to the network and the definitive map since 2006 are shown on the interactive countryside map, which is available [here](#).
