I am writing to formally confirm the grant from my office to the Oxfordshire Community Safety Partnership for the next three years. As proposed last year and supported by the Police & Crime Panel the funding will be as follows:

2022/23 £686820 2023/24 £699307 2024/25 £712271 3 year total £2098398

As you will be aware in Oxfordshire the CSF allocation is to the County Council with local arrangements in place to devolve funding further. There remains great strength in the joined up approach being taken wherever possible across Oxfordshire and my office will continue to support this work.

I am committed to working closely with CSPs, not only with continued direct funding, but also by supporting your staff and seeking opportunities for external funding. My Head of Partnerships & Community Safety, Cath Marriott, has already been liaising with Community Safety Managers regarding the new processes for accessing the funding and the flexibility to spread some of the funding across the three year programme in support of the priorities set out in my Police & Criminal Justice Plan.
