



Supplementary Planning Document Joint Design Guide Adoption Statement

South Oxfordshire District Council and the Vale of White Horse adopted the following Supplementary Document on 23rd June and 24th June 2022 respectively.

This adoption statement is required by Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended). Any person aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Supplementary Document was adopted.
