Reduce and reuse

We should all be trying to reduce the amount of waste we produce. Here are some top tips to help you reduce and reuse.

- Buy your food naked... (we mean without packaging).
- Support small businesses and the planet by shopping at your local zero waste store.
- · Sell or give away unwanted items online or to a charity shop.
- Take broken items to your local repair café.
- When food shopping, take a list and only buy what you need.

Bag your batteries!

Please do not put electrical items, batteries or gas canisters in any bin - they can all cause fires in the back of our trucks and put our crews at risk.

Small electrical items should be put in a carrier bag next to your black bin, batteries go in a small, clear bag on top of your recycling bin and gas canisters need to be taken to a household waste recycling centre or returned to the supplier.

And remember, you can also put worn out textiles such as clothes, bedsheets and duvet covers out for collection too. Just leave them in a tied carrier bag next to your green recycling bin.

Please use the correct bin

While most of us are great at using the correct bin, we are still having to reject lots of recycling because recycling bins have food waste, nappies and other wrong materials in them. Remember, food waste should always go in your small green food caddy so it can be made into energy and fertiliser, not in your recycling bin, while used nappies should go in your waste bin.


Too much waste to fit in your bin?



We do collect extra recycling, contents must be visible for crews to see, so please put it in a cardboard box or a clear sack next to your green recycling bin. Never use a black sack!

Bins not emptied?

All bins should be put out for collection before 6am with the lids firmly closed to allow them to be easily attached to the bin lorry for emptying.

If your waste isn't collected and you put your bins out on time, please report it to us and we will aim to return for it. This also applies for textiles, batteries or small electricals.

Report a missed collection via our website whitehorsedc.gov.uk/missedbins or by using the contact details below. You must submit your report by the next working day after your collection was due – by 5pm if you are phoning, or by midnight if you report it online.

Disruption of services

We will communicate any disruption of our services, for reasons such as very cold weather, extreme heat or staff shortages, through our website and social media.
